Over the past fifteen years Jim Mason's career has developed from a songwriter-recording artist on such labels as RCA, ABC Dunhill, and Columbia, to become one of today's most active producers.

This has definitely turned out to be a busy year for Jim Mason, who is probably destined for a heavy future as well.
