His first solo production was "Mother's Finest," and since then, Tom has been busy producing groups he has signed to Epic (Ted Nugent, Cheap Trick, Mother's Finest, Molly Hatchet) with a stint as executive producer for "Jeff Beck Live with the Jan Hammer Group." His next project is Brownsville Station. Thus far, Tom Werman has produced four records that have achieved platinum status. We're certain that he'll add many more to the list!
